KIZ ZONE MODIFICATION

- 1. Keystone Innovation Zones may be modified upon formal request of the KIZ Partnership. The following guidelines apply:
 - a. Sufficient justification must exist, namely:
 - i. The current space is underutilized and space outside the KIZ exists which is more conducive to KIZ companies, or
 - ii. Additional space is needed;
 - b. The new area is contiguous to the existing KIZ; and
 - c. Where possible, the Partnership is willing to swap an underutilized area within the KIZ for a new area outside the KIZ to prevent an increase in the size of the existing KIZ.
- 2. In the event that an underutilized area within a KIZ is swapped out or otherwise removed from the KIZ, the KIZ partnership must submit for each keystone innovation zone company, as defined in 12 Pa.C.S. § 3702, which would cease to remain a keystone innovation zone company following a zone modification, a signed written statement that it consents to the proposed KIZ modification.
- 3. Only minor geographical changes are permitted.
- 4. All geography modification requests must be submitted to the Department through the Keystone Innovation Zone Coordinator.
