

POLICY ADVISORY COUNCIL

To ensure the Weatherization Assistance Program meets the needs of residents, DCED has a dedicated Policy Advisory Council. Members include electric utilities and associations, service providers, energy advocacy groups, social service and government agencies.

WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Pennsylvania residents with an income 200% or below the Federal Poverty Guidelines set by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services are eligible to receive services through the Weatherization Assistance Program. A household is automatically eligible to receive assistance if an individual living in the dwelling receives Supplemental Security Income.

Priority is given to higher-risk residents including the elderly, disabled individuals, families with children, and high energy users.

SERVICES


Direct weatherization services are provided through a network of public and non-profits agencies operating in single counties or multi-county regions. Services focus on:

- Diagnostic assessment of air leakage
- Health and safety repairs
- Electric baseload measures
- Client energy education
