

CORRECTED FINAL ORDER

AND NOW, this 20th day of June, 2017, to correct Petitioner's name in the caption, the State Board of Property as a ministerial act incorporates by reference the adjudication and reissues its final order of April 21, 2017, and repeats without substantive change the final order as follows: Having duly convened and considered the entire record of the proceedings, and based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Discussion, the State Board of Property hereby **GRANTS IN PART** Petitioner's prayer for relief and orders that, as the boundary line between Petitioner's property and that of Respondent is as shown as the compromise boundary line of Department of Forest and Waters Map File 2730, Petitioner and not Respondent is the owner of the real property within the triangle identified as "lands claimed by Hammermill Paper Co. (now Niles Lumber Co.)." Respondent shall not assert any right, title or interest inconsistent with this boundary line.

This order shall be effective retroactive to April 21, 2017.
