

Pennsylvania Economic Development Financing Authority

NHS-AVS, LLC – Series 2008 Conversion Resolution

Mr. Drizos stated, "The item on the agenda is the NHS-AVS, LLC Series 2008 Conversion Resolution. You have had an opportunity to read the resolution, which approves changes to the private transaction that was done in 2008 through PEDFA. At that time the interest rate was a variable demand note. That issue was for \$54 million dollars. The company, which is a non-profit, has elected to change or add another mode to be entered into. They have a buyer for the new bonds, which are not to exceed \$40 million dollars, which is T. D. Bank.
