### MOVING AT THE SPEED OF BUSINESS

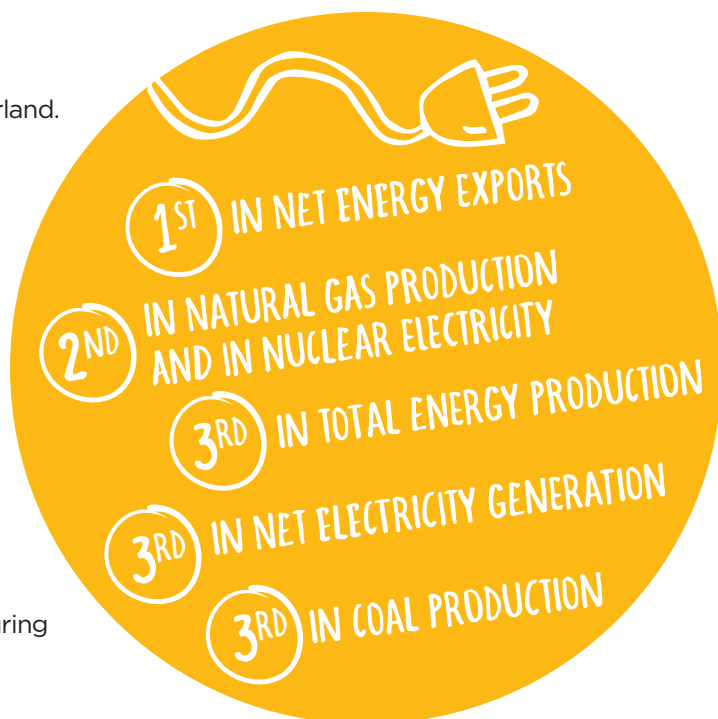
