- Amount of funds received by the municipality or county in the prior calendar year. This applies each year funds are disbursed from the grant.
- A description of how the funds were used; either deposited in a general fund or committed to a specific use or project. If specific use or project, a narrative is required.

- G. **Conflict of Interest** Market, direct or employee of an applicant who is a party to or has a private interest in a project and disclose the natural extent of the interest to the governing body of the applicant, and may be vote on action of the plicant concerning the project, nor participate in the deliberations of the pplicant concerning the project.
