and not in the public interest;

That the requested funding of said unfunded debt, and the proposed maturities and
interest, will not endanger the rendering of services or require the levying of excessive taxes; and

That the debt is within the statutory limitations of Section 8022 of the Local Government
Unit Debt Act, as amended, and all such debt shall be charged against the nonelectoral debt
limitations of said section. (Or, if requested by the local government unit, the Court may order
that the debt not be charged against the debt limits).

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE INDEBTEDNESS OF _____, _____ COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, BY THE ISSUE OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION NOTE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$_____ FOR SUNDRY PURPOSES; FIXING THE FORM, NUMBER, DATE, INTEREST, AND MATURITY THEREOF; MAKING A COVENANT FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE DEBT SERVICE ON THE NOTE; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF THE REQUIRED DOCUMENT; PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A SINKING FUND DEPOSITORY FOR THE NOTE; AND AUTHORIZING EXECUTION, SALE AND DELIVERY THEREOF.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the indebtedness of the _____, _____ County, Pennsylvania be increased for the following purpose:

WHEREAS, the local government unit has received preliminary realistic cost estimates from professional consultants indicating the sum of \$_____ will be needed to complete the project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed increase of debt, together with its nonelectoral indebtedness and its lease rental indebtedness presently outstanding, will not cause the limitations of the local government unit debt incurring power, pursuant to constitutional and statutory authority to be exceeded;

SECTION 1. That the aggregate principal amount of the Note of the

SECTION 2. The period of useful life of the improvements for which this obligation is to

SECTION 3. Said indebtedness shall be evidenced by one general obligation Note, in
fully registered form, in the sum of \$_____ dated and bearing interest from the
earliest date of possible issue of said Note under the statutory time requirements as set forth in

of April, 1978, being Act 52 of 1978 Session and known as the Local Government Unit Debt

SECTION 6. The said Note shall be executed in the name and under the corporate seal of the local government unit by the _____ and _____ and attested to by the Secretary. The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to deliver said Note to the purchaser, and receive payment therefor on behalf of the local government unit. The _____ and Secretary of the local government unit are authorized and directed to prepare, verify and file the debt statement required by Section 8110 of the Act and to take other necessary action, including, if necessary or desirable, any statements required to qualify any portion of the debt from the appropriate debt limit as self-liquidating or subsidized debt.

SECTION 7. _____ (Bank or Bank and Trust Company) is hereby designated as the Sinking Fund Depository for the obligation herein authorized, and there is hereby created and established a Sinking Fund, to be known as “Sinking Fund 20___ General Obligation Note” for the payment of the principal and interest thereon which shall be deposited into the Sinking Fund no later than the date upon which the same becomes due and payable. The Treasurer shall deposit into the Sinking Fund, which shall be maintained until such obligation is paid in full, sufficient amounts for payment of principal and interest on the obligation no later than the date upon which such payments shall become due. The Sinking Fund Depository shall, as and when said payments are due, without further action by the local government unit, withdraw available monies in the Sinking Fund and apply said monies to payment of principal and interest on the obligation.

SECTION 8. The _____ and _____ of the local government unit are hereby authorized to contract with _____ (Bank or Bank and Trust Company) for its services as Sinking Fund Depository for the Note and paying agent for the same.

SECTION 9. In compliance with Section 8161 of the Act, the members of the governing body have determined that a private sale by negotiation rather than public sale is in the best financial interest of the local government unit. Therefore, the general obligation Note in the amount of \$_____, herein authorized to be issued and sold is hereby awarded and sold to _____ (Lender) in accordance with its proposal to purchase the said Note at par; provided the said Note is dated the delivery thereof to the _____ (Lender) and is in the form set forth in this Ordinance as Exhibit N; and further provided that the proceedings have been approved by the Department of Community and Economic Development if such approval is required under the provisions of the Act.
