

WEATHERIZATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

HELPING FAMILIES REDUCE ENERGY COSTS

Pennsylvania's Weatherization Assistance Program (WAP) helps residents lower their energy costs by increasing the energy efficiency of their homes, while ensuring their health and safety.

State and local effort from WAP reduce national energy consumption and the impact of higher fuel costs on families by using the most advanced technologies and testing protocols available in the housing industry.

The PA Department of Community & Economic Development (DCED) administers WAP with the advisement of a dedicated Policy Advisory Council (PAC) which includes representatives from electric utilities and associations, service providers, energy advocacy groups, social service and government agencies. The PAC's members provide oversight and recommendations to ensure the program meets the needs of residents, and works toward coordination of all weatherization services.



WHO'S ELIGIBLE?

Pennsylvania residents with an income 200% or below the Federal Poverty Guidelines set by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services are eligible to receive services through the Weatherization Assistance Program. A household is automatically eligible to receive assistance if an individual living in the dwelling receives Supplemental Security Income.

Priority is given to higher-risk residents including the elderly, disabled individuals, families with children, and high energy users.

SERVICES

Direct weatherization services are provided through a network of public and non-profits agencies operating in single counties or multi-county regions. Services focus on:

- Diagnostic assessment of air leakage
- Health and safety repairs
- Electric baseload measures
- Client energy education
